




We are drawing near that time of year again when we volunteer in the Ballance tent at Fieldays.

What is blood cancer?

There are eight grown-ups and kids diagnosed with blood cancer each day in New Zealand.
You might know someone going through blood cancer right now – they can have

strange names like leukaemia, lymphoma and myeloma.

It can be a really difficult and painful thing to go through.

WE ALSO NEED COACHES AND MANAGERS! This is especially the case for the younger teams, so please consider helping out in these rewarding roles and let me know by email.


