

NGAHINAPOURI SCHOOL
AGRICULTURAL DAY RULES

General Rules – Please read carefully.

1. Children's ages to be as at day of judging.
2. No two pupils can show the same calf, lamb or kid.
3. No animals to be carrying lice.
4. Animals must have been first shown at school day to become eligible for Group Day unless an exemption is granted due to illness or other exceptional circumstances.
5. Parents may assist their children in cleaning animals on arrival at Agricultural Day.
6. Pre-schoolers are welcome to compete at school day but **NOT** Group or Show Days.
7. For Champion Ribbons to be awarded there needs to be at least 8 children competing in one section (eg. calves, lambs or kids).

Section Rules:

Calves: Dairy or Beef

1. Bull calves are accepted at Agricultural Day but Group Day and Show Day rules may differ so inquire where applicable.
2. Calves must not be clipped or oiled.
3. TB Certificates are to accompany all calves to all competition days.
4. All calves to have a NAIT tag in RIGHT ear

Lambs:

1. Lambs must not be washed – they may be covered and brushed.
2. Ram lambs are accepted at Agricultural Day but Group Day and Show Day rules may differ so inquire where applicable.

Kids:

1. Any breed or combination of breeds will be accepted.
2. Milking, Meat or Feral Goats may be washed and brushed but not fibre goats (eg. Angora, Mohair etc.).
3. Buck kids are accepted at Agricultural Day but Group Day and Show Day rules may differ so inquire where applicable.

COVID 19 Protocols

The following protocols will be in place for our Agricultural Day

- At Level 2 the park will be split into 2 areas. **Parents and students must stay in their one area and not cross between the two areas.**
- Children and calves to practice social distancing.
- There will be no waiting in a shared area. Children will bring their calf to the ring entrance once the child in front of them has entered the ring.
- No-one is to pat anyone else's animal.
- TB Cards must be taken to all days – Agricultural, Group and Show days.
- All calves to have a NAIT tag in RIGHT ear
